

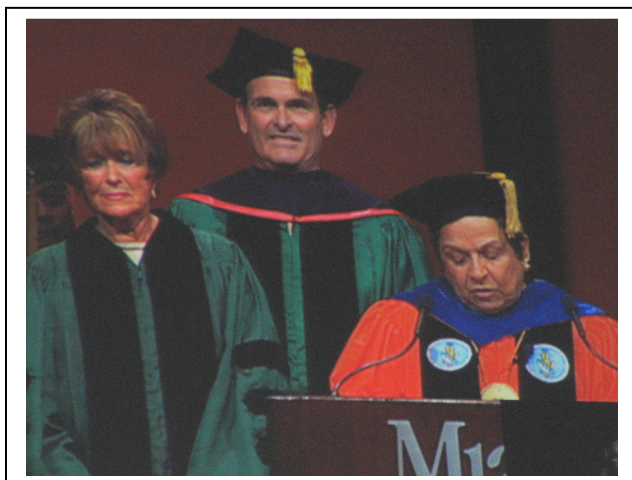
**Sue Miller receives
